Kabele Truck & Auto Parts Spirit Lake, IA www.Kabele.com In comments submitted to the government, the association explained that the auto care industry's "ability to source parts..... keeps vehicle repair and maintenance costs affordable for working families."¹ No mention was made of used auto parts as an alternative product that lifts the U.S. economy, supports environmental goals for reduced pollution from new product creation and transportation emissions nor the value-added benefit to consumers in car repair.

'The association's comments further explained that "the availability of affordable high-quality parts from foreign sources creates thousands of jobs that might be threatened should the Trump administration move forward with a tariff on vehicles and vehicle parts."

Included in the comments was a recent economic study completed for the Auto Care Association by John Dunham and Associates, which found that a 25 percent tariff on imported auto parts could cause a reduction of 17,800 jobs in the auto parts manufacturing sector, resulting in \$1.4 billion in lost wages. The study further predicts that 6,800 jobs would be lost by

No Tariff on Used Auto Parts

vehicle repair shops... These are mostly small family-owned businesses that would suffer severe economic harm should a 25 percent tariff be levied on autos and auto parts.'¹ READ The story at <u>https://autobodynews.com</u>.

The commissioned study may not be *inaccurate* but it is certainly bias by not including the "Used Auto Parts Affect" and the impact sourcing domestic used auto parts would have on reducing the predicted scarcity.

The threat or promise of tariff is creating an uncertain business environment. This <u>uncertainty is also an unprecedented opportunity for automotive recyclers</u> to reach out to your repair shop customers with a message. The message is **OFFER USED AUTO PART OPTIONS ON ALL QUOTES** to build consumer confidence in car repair in an era of uncertainty.

The oversight reminds me of the story John C Vander Haag tells about an era long ago when a man from the government or "G Man" came out to his yard to justify stopping used auto parts sales so that more metal could go to the war effort. John immediately told the fellow "No Sir!" And explained that used auto parts were more important than ever to give the people low cost options to keep their cars running. As well as helping folks to not be affected by the parts scarcity that would inevitably follow when manufacturers were tied up in wartime production. The story goes that Mr. Vander Haag then proceeded to give that G Man a swift kick in the, well, let's just say that those were days of action and not of figuratively speaking...

Today should also be a time of action. Send a letter to repair shops, both customers and non-customers including dealerships, to tell them that automotive recycling is still here providing used auto parts for affordable car repair options.

ARA Responds to General Motors Ban on **Recycled Bumpers**

ARA issued a press release on June 15 calling a recent position statement by General Motors (GM), in which the automobile manufacturer bans the use of aftermarket, reconditioned, or

salvage Bumpers/Fascias on vehicles equipped with advanced driver assistance systems (ADAS), a disservice to consumers. GM references the company's commitment to safety and says that such parts might have

"different material specifications than what was designed, tested and validated for use with ADAS." "The fact is," said ARA Interim CEO Sandy Blalock, "the genuine, original equipment manufacturer (OEM) recycled parts that ARA members sell are the very same parts manufactured by General Motors. They are genuine GM parts, designed by GM and built to meet their requirements for fit, finish, durability, reliability and safety. For the company to effectively ban the reutilization of their own parts speaks not to a commitment to safety, but rather a commitment to forcing lower-cost alternative parts out of the market." Following the GM action, Honda updat-


ed its position statement on June 21 regarding the repair of vehicles with ADAS to state that using anything other than an OEM part for windshield and grill repairs would put the vehicle at risk. These are just the latest examples of auto manufacturers' taking aggressive steps to monopolize their market share. ARA continues to dialogue with stakeholders in the federal government and broader repair industry to build support for holding automakers accountable for their ac-
