ARA Members Meet in Washington, DC for Another Successful Hill Day and Legislative Summit

ARA leadership, members and staff recently met for the Association's annual Hill Day, Legislative Summit and Board of Directors meeting in Washington, D.C. In a packed agenda, ARA held a Board meeting on the first day which included ARA Committee and budget reports.

The second day included the state-focused Legislative Summit where participants representing 15 states shared legislative updates and discussion focused on how to handle older vehicles without a title, the value of electronic stolen vehicle systems, and varied stormwater enforcement. In the afternoon, attendees participated in a leadership training session.

On the third day, ARA members visited with their elected officials. The message ARA brought to Capitol Hill this year was to educate their Members of Congress - House and Senate - and solicit co-sponsorship support for legislation that would require auto manufacturers to provide professional automotive recyclers with all parts data. Meetings were held with over 45 Congressional offices and 17 of those meetings were with the Member of Congress. ARA members were successful in getting at least two cosponsors for the House legislation and dozens of offices are now studying the issue and seriously interested in providing support.




A circular economy is an alternative to a traditional linear economy (make, use, dispose) in which we keep resources in use for as long as possible, extract the maximum value from them whilst in use, then recover and regenerate products and materials at the end of each service life. Wikipedia

"The concept of a circular economy (CE) has been first raised by two British environmental economists David W. Pearce and R. Kerry Turner. In <u>Economics of Natural Resources and the Environment</u>, they pointed out that a traditional open-ended economy was developed with no built-in tendency to recycle, which was reflected by treating the environment as a waste reservoir". The circular economy is grounded in the study of feedback-rich systems, particularly living systems. A major outcome of this is the notion of optimizing *systems* rather than *components* drawing from a number of more specific approaches including cradle-to-cradle, biomimicry, industrial ecology and the 'blue economy'. What is old, is new again

about limited resources and recovery of raw material and remanufacturing concepts. Which seems like a good thing until you scratch your head and think "Hey, didn't auto recyclers start doing that the day after the cars started rolling off the assembly line?" The answer is, of course, yes. But old things are new again in a cyclical manner. History repeats itself as soon as the current masters of the universe discovery what the previous masters knew.

The real question for auto recycling is not what is a circular economy, but "how can we tap in to the trend?"

Engagement. A world with little or no waste – it's not just a nice idea for the distant future, it's a means of improving the environment, public health and even profit margins today.

Companies across many industries are moving towards the idea of a circular economy as an alternative to the traditional linear model of make, use, dispose. In many regions around the world, governments are stepping up with support in the form of guidance and legislation. That translate to taking a

legislative approach to require manufacturers to truly engage in the circular economy and not just provide lips service while feeling good about using old blue jeans to make carpet.

"The automotive industry depends on different raw materials to produce vehicles. Much of the supply of materials goes to car manufacturing. An increase in demand will lead to increases in prices, which can potentially increase the costs to car manufacturers," explained Khaled Soufani of Cambridge Judge Business School.



It is already playing out in a variety of ways, and Soufani points specifically to the concept of 'reverse logistics' as it relates to reusing mate-

rials.¹

"There are also other issues relating to the industry exploring ways to use less energy and apply more innovative ways of **reusing**, **remanufacturing**, **and reconditioning**," he added, suggesting that more research is needed in this area.¹

Auto recyclers call it core processing, remanufacturing, rebuilding and replacing worn or broken parts with quality used auto parts under warranty instead of replacing parts

or vehicles with new. But more research can only help the auto recycling industry.

By-the-way, **Servitisation** is a relatively recent concept adopted by manufacturers to deliver a service component in tandem with their traditional product - providing added value to customers, securing orders and boosting profitability.

Capacity sharing refers to one supplier with an expertise or stellar product supplying all businesses in need of their product, even if they are competitors. This seems fairly commonplace, but as a new business model, the upshot would be for auto parts to be more interchangeable not less.


lowa Certified Automotive Recyclers Environmental Program

lowa auto salvage yards with more than 250 vehicles in the yard are required to sample storm water (rain) runoff for parameters listed below.

All lowa automotive salvage facilities are required to have a storm water permit regardless of whether or not you need to sample. **Collect and submit rainfall samples to a laboratory for analysis annually.**

Retain a copy of the report with the Storm water Pollution Prevention Plan (SWPPP). It is not required to submit the report to the regulatory agency but it must be maintained on-site in the event an inspector requests to see it.

Both sets of samples, the grab and the composite, must be tested for five parameters: five-day biochemical oxygen demand (BOD); chemical oxygen demand (COD); total suspended solids (TSS); total Kjeldahl nitrogen (TKN); total phosphorus. The grab sample must be tested for two additional parameters: oil and grease; pH. pH must be field tested.

Storm Water

Sample Kits

There are no regulatory limits on the values of test results, only that the samples are taken and analyzed. Any analytical laboratory with the capacity to test storm water may conduct the testing procedures. An arrangement has been made with TestAmerica to conduct the samples through Sue Schauls that will ensure accuracy in the testing procedures including using the parameters required and reporting data accurately. Collect a representative grab sample and a composite sample of rainwater flowing off the property (outfall location).

SAMPLING MADE EASY

STEP ONE: In the first hour of a rainfall of significance (about 2 inches) using the storm water kit (cooler) received from TestAmerica, collect water in a clean cup and fill the bottles marked "composite" 1/3 full then fill all the bottles marked "grab" completely full.

ON-SITE pH Testing Remove the pH STRIPS from the small vial and fill the vial with sample water. Dip one pH strip in the water then record the value correlated to the color (see chart) on the Chain=of-costody.

The vial DOES NOT have to go back to the lab and the un-used pH strip can be retained for future use. This is called FIELD TESTING FOR pH.

STEP TWO: If at least 15 minutes have passed, then fill the composite sample bottles another 1/3 full .

STEP THREE: Wait 15 more minutes and fill the bottles the rest of the way full. Do overfill or overflow.

STEP FOUR: Date and sign the form, called the Chainof-Custody, paperwork with your name, the name of the facility where the sample was taken and the date and time the sample was taken.

Sign the form and place it in a plastic bag in the cooler.

A separate bag is included for ICE!

STEP FIVE: Deliver or ship the collection kit to TestAmerica in CEDRA FALLS, IA using the included shipping label and prefilled CHAIN OF CUSTODY.

ADD ICE TO THE SAMPLE KIT IF IT WILL NOT BE DELIVERED THE SAME DAY (An ice bag is included)

Comprehensive Parts Data Legislation Reintroduced in U.S. House

Rep. Adam Kinzinger (R-IL) reintroduced a bill - H.R. 2460 - in the U.S. House that will provide professional automotive recyclers with access to all OEM parts data. In the last Congress, he succeeded in getting a provision enacted into law that provides this information on safety recalled parts. ARA has worked with the Congressman for over two years on this new legislation and has fine-tuned the bill to have the accessible data include:

"Each original equipment manufacturer (OEM) part name included with such vehicle, a description of each such part, each part number (including any superseded and successor OEM part number), any other part identification number (such as a serial number) and distinguishing marking of each such part, and the software of each such part (if applicable) ... Build sheet information...Additional information as determined by the Secretary."

ARA applauds Congressman
Kinzinger for his thoughtful consideration and action on this issue critical to
the future of automotive recycling. An
effort to secure cosponsors for the
new legislation was the goal of the recent ARA Hill Day and there was much
interest by his colleagues. As a result,
the bill will have at least two original cosponsors.



ARA Leadership Meets with Federal Trade Commission

ARA met with representatives of the FTC to discuss the anti-competitive/ monopolistic nature of actions by auto manufacturers. The meeting continued dialogue about disparaging marketing practices of the automakers towards recycled OEM parts. ARA discussed professional automotive recycling and inventory management systems. ARA specifically noted the proliferation of automotive parts coupled with the constraints in which the recycling industry works.
