Hotlines' Betsy Finnell Speaks about her passion for the industry

Helping recyclers make more money has been our family mantra forever.

My parents Jim (known as "Chick") and Betty Finnell, started A & A Auto Salvage in Topeka, Kansas, in 1957 with \$500. ***I sometimes say I may not have grease under my fingernails but it's in my blood.***

I grew up at the dinner table listening to my parents discuss the heavy challenges they faced each day as small business owners in this industry. I watched them continually battle diverse issues such as eminent domain, OSHA, and environmental impact. During this time President Lyndon Johnson's wife, Lady Bird, initiated her national campaign against the "dirty junk yards." As you might imagine, my mom, being a "dirty junk yard" owner, took great exception to this. Mom wrote President and Mrs. Johnson describing all the work she had done to beautify their salvage yard and the pride they had in owning it. Mrs. Johnson was thrilled to

receive the letter and contacted mom personally. As a result, mom was invited to several receptions at the White House and asked to serve on the President's National Beautification Committee.

Mom started the Kansas State Auto Wreckers Association and formed a national lobby group for recycler interests. She was responsible for getting 4,000 telegrams sent to Washington back in the 1970's to stop a particularly dangerous piece of legislation from moving forward.

Anti-Trust reminder – Sue called the meeting to order at 9:04 and took roll call. She asked Eric Piper, Vice President, to conduct the meeting.

Lobbyist Contract:

Eric stated the purpose of the meeting was to discuss the Lobbyist contract. Jim has been paid one half of his contract amount (\$10,000) and has not been paid the other half for 2017. \$10,000 is due to Jim as the Association is under contract to make full payment.

As last reported in the 9-6-17 Board minutes, Jim reported receiving information on the DOT five year review and on several items including work on definitions, salvage title situations, and salvage theft exams. Jim had planned to set up a meeting between DOT and IAR Board but the meeting never transpired.

January 26, 2018—Teleconference Call—9:00 am

There was discussion as to what the next contract should include such as better communication between the contracted lobbyist and the Board, the expectation set forth with monetary consequences, and more oversight by the Legislative Committee. The Board also thought they could do better with communication between themselves and the Lobbyist.

It was decided that 2018 will be either a gap year or a monitoring legislative year. The Board also decided to have the 2019 contract ready for review by October 1, 2018 (as had been discussed in previous years) so that everyone is aware of the goals and expectations in advance of the new contract year.

After a lengthy discussion on Jim's performance issues, Tom S moved to the Legislative Committee of Mike S, Pat and Sue to meet with Jim face-to-face to do the following: pay Jim the balance due for 2017, to discuss the fee for future "monitor only" contract, and to discuss the 2019 contract that outlines expectation more clearly. Eric P seconded the motion. Motion carried. Mike S will initiate the meeting time and place. After that there will be a conference call to discuss the outcome of the meeting and make plans to move forward.

Upcoming Meetings:

Sue will arrange a teleconference call for Tuesday, January 30th at 5:15 pm to follow up on agenda items from this meeting that did not get discussed. She will also arrange a face-to face Board Meeting in Des Moines in April.

There was a motion to adjourn and a second. Meeting was adjourned at 10:27 am.

IOWA AUTO RECYCLERS ASSOCIATION SCHOLARSHIP

APPLICANT CRITERIA:

- Be a graduating high school senior or equivalent, or a college student who has been accepted to an accredited university, state college, community college, business or liberal arts school
- A minimum 3.0 GPA during high school or first year college.
- Applicants (or their eligible dependent/relative) must be affiliated with the Iowa Auto Recyclers Association to participate by meeting ONE of two criteria:
 - 1) Be a recycling yard owner or relative of the recycling yard owner who is a direct member of the Iowa Auto Recyclers. The owner of the recycling yard must be employed at the recycling yard, and not at other enterprises owned by the recycling yard. "Relatives" may include a son, daughter, grandchild, son-in-law, daughter-in-law, or spouse of the owner. Brothers, sisters, uncles, aunts, nieces, or nephews of the owner will not be eligible to participate unless employed in the business.

OR

- 2) Be an employee or dependent of an employee of the member salvage yard who has been employed for one year or more. Applicant must remain a degree-seeking student, enrolled at least full-time (a minimum of 12 credit hours per term).

APPLICANT GUIDELINES:

- Complete attached application, download at www.iowaAutoRecyclers.com under SCHOLARSHIP
- Enclose an official copy of the applicants' high school transcripts (in separate sealed envelope) with application.
- Include a one page essay on one of the following topic:

Do you think that young people know about, understand and/or support the environmental benefits of automotive parts recycling? How do you think the message can be spread to the younger generation about these benefits and the cost savings of used auto parts for car repair?

- Two recommendation forms filled out from a school counselor, school official, employer or high school teacher who is familiar with the applicant.
- Applicants must remain enrolled in the same accredited four-year college, accredited university, state college, community college or business or liberal arts school for at least one year after accepting scholarship funds to be eligible for the full award.
- Obtain a letter from your parents' employer confirming date of hire with the firm. Your parent must have been or will be employed with a full member of the Iowa Automotive Recyclers for at least one year prior to application.

All candidates will be required to submit a complete application package, which includes a completed application form, transcripts, essay and two recommendation forms to:

DEADLINE DATE: The deadline for receipt for all application materials must be received by the IAR scholarship committee by midnight MARCH 15TH. Up to \$5000.00 will be awarded in scholarships for the fall term. The winners will be notified in writing in April and will be posted on the IAR website.

The scholarship award check will be forwarded to the scholarship recipient's school upon written certification of his/her enrollment for the fall term of the year the scholarship was granted. If the scholarship winner does not provide enrollment verification for the fall term the scholarship monies will be forfeited.

SCHOLARSHIP SELECTION: The scholarship will be awarded based on review of the following: course work in high school, course distribution, activities, the one page essay and recommendations. *Standardized test scores will NOT be used as a factor in the selection process.*

International Safety Standard ISO 45001

Publish Date Set for March 15, 2018

The International Organization for Standardization is the system that is widely known for the ISO 9000 Quality Standards in manufacturing. ISO 140001 is the Environmental Standards. ISO 45001 Occupational Health and Safety Management Systems Standard will be published on March 15, 2018. OHSAS 18001 will be withdrawn, leaving a 3 year period for transition to the new standard.

The burden of occupational injuries and diseases is significant, both for employers and the wider economy, resulting in losses from early retirements, staff absence and rising insurance premiums.

To combat the problem, ISO is developing a new standard, ISO 45001, *Occupational health and safety management systems - Requirements*, that will help organizations reduce this burden by providing a framework to improve employee safety, reduce workplace risks and create better, safer working conditions, all over the world.

The standard is currently being developed by a committee of occupational health and safety experts, and will follow other generic management system approaches such as ISO 14001 and ISO 9001. It will take into account other International Standards in this area such as [OHSAS 18001](#), the International Labour Organization's [ILO-OSH Guidelines](#), various national standards and the ILO's international labour standards and conventions.

OSHA releases statement on fatal occupational injuries in 2016

Fatalities decline in the waste and recycling industry

The Bureau of Labor Statistics' "[Census of 2016 Fatal Occupational Injuries](#)" reports 5,190 workplace fatalities occurred in 2016, a 7 percent increase from 2015. The fatal injury rate also increased from 3.4 per 100,000 full-time equivalent workers in 2015 to 3.6 in 2016. The census was based on data from the (OSHA).

Despite this overall increase, in the public and private waste and recycling industry, fatalities declined from 50 in 2015 to 42 in 2016.

"This should give our industry a little encouragement that our organizational commitment to a strong safety culture and our safety processes are having an impact," National Waste & Recycling Association President and CEO Darrell Smith says in a news release responding to the OSHA data. He says the NWRA

and its members will continue to look for opportunities to improve. "Zero is possible." More workers lost their lives in transportation incidents than any other event in 2016, accounting for about 1 out of every 4 fatal injuries, OSHA says.

The Log should be posted in an area accessible to all employees.

DOING BUSINESS WITH INSURANCE ADJUSTERS?

I've been in the industry my entire business career. Mom's lifelong mission to champion the industry and help the individual recyclers made a huge impression on me. She was the best business mentor a young woman could have asked for, and a continuation of her work is the reason I'm here today. I continue to remain very passionate about the industry.

In 1984 I joined mom, to create and market a nationwide parts locator, DataNet, which was one of the first nationwide used auto parts locating networks for recyclers. I would make presentations to groups of recyclers around the country telling them about our network. I made my first presentation by myself to a group of 89 recyclers in North Carolina when I was 24. I was terrified. Mom had taken out a second mortgage her home to finance the cost of creating DataNet and it was a do-or die deal as far as I was concerned. I was convinced that if I wasn't able to convince the group to join our network that mom would be eating dirt and turnips for the rest of her life I made an impassioned presentation and the group ended up voting unanimously to go with our network. No dirt and turnips for mom!

In 1986 mom sold the business to AutoInfo (the creators of the Checkmate inventory system). I served on the AutoInfo team as Group Vice President, Sales & Marketing from 1986 through 1995, when AutoInfo divested its Automotive Recycling Division to ADP Hollander. I joined the ADP Hollander team as Director, New Business Development Auto Recycling Division from 1995 through 2002. I stayed with

the ADP team until 2003 when Mike Vande Voort, owner of Hotlines, Inc., approached me about becoming his partner. I've been co-owner of Hotlines ever since.

Hotlines is a network of the top recyclers across the country and uses real-time, live access to member inventories for the most accurate parts buying and selling in the nation. One of the major things that make Hotlines special and different from the other networks is that Hotlines is made up of member recyclers. Each member is voted on based on his business practices. We have a monthly collection roll call that is *second to none* in the industry. We work with members to help keep their bills to other members current. insurance carriers, the large consolidators, or collecting and re-selling the recycler's data. We're in it for the recycler. Period. If the recycler is not YOUR master, then we have nothing else to talk about."

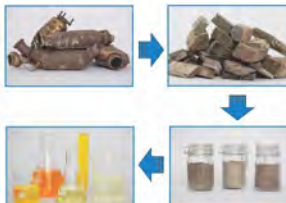
