President Eric Piper called the meeting to order at 5:20 p.m. and reminded everyone of the Anti-Trust Statement. He also welcomed the new board members.

<u>Hybrid Training Class</u> – Sue said Andy Latham (ARA member from the UK) will do a 6-hour training on hybrid dismantling in Iowa on Thursday, October 11th followed by a 2nd class at Nordstrom's in Garretson, SD on Friday, October 12th. Andy's fee is \$1500 per class. The more participation we have the lower the cost per individual to attend the class. The lunch at Nordstrom's will be covered by them.

After some discussion, it was decided to have the Iowa class at a location in the Iowa City area. The venue and lunch will add cost. Sue will determine the venue (with Joel's help) and then each out to vendors to see if they want to participate. Vendors discussed included Dorman and MCI/ACE Core. Sue will send out a flyer to the Iowa membership and advertise it as \$129/attendee.

<u>Midwest Runner Update</u> – Sue asked if we will be re-scheduling the meeting with the Midwest Runner organization. The majority opinion among the members was that the added cost of getting a driver to a hub daily is not cost efficient. Sue will request a proposal on a petal route.

Sue also shared information Tom Snyder sent about an upcoming CIECA webinar that Jim McKinney was putting on for the collision repair industry promoting used auto parts and the ease of parts shipping through MidWest Runner.

<u>Hotlines NXG</u> – There are 17 lowa yards using this program. Jodi questioned whether the shipping portion has savings over any other shipping options as she compared (she is not using Hotlines currently). Betsy with Hotlines has given a report to Sue on the usage by lowa members that highlighted that some yards are not quoting the auto matches. Eric also noted that he uses the eCommerce Toolbox feature for sales to the public and that Hotlines called him to remind him that he has orders to attend, which he was a nice benefit. A few pros and cons voiced by the members on the call were:

It is a good way to sell some older inventory at a discount.

The auto-match works well but matches must be quoted which takes some time monitoring.

It seems to need a dedicated attention from staff to use Hotlines effectively.

It's a less time-consuming way to advertise than EBay.

Hybrid Dismantlers Training October 11& 12, 2018

Excerpt from the ARA guide:

"properly recycle end of life hybrid batteries"

With the introduction of the first Hybrid Electric Vehicles (HEV) from Honda in 1999 and then Toyota in 2001, the job of the automotive recycler became more complex regarding the dismantling of the HEV for the purpose of resale and recycling of the high voltage batteries in these types of vehicles. Although every HEV uses a 12-volt battery to operate the majority of the electrical accessories on the vehicle, the HEV also is equipped with a High Voltage (HV) battery pack. Voltage levels of these battery packs range from 36 volts on some mid 2000's GM BAS (Belt Alternator Starter) light hybrid versions to up to over 350 volts found in the 435 pound lithium ion battery pack seen in the Chevy Volt. The EV1 Electric Vehicle (EV) predated the HEV as the first EV built by General Motors in the late 1990's. GM's EV1 contained 1,300 pounds of lead-acid batteries to have a total HV battery pack voltage level of slightly over 300 volts. Production for the EV1 ended in the early

2000's, but before production ended the EV1 had transitioned to the technology that HEVs from Japan had begun utilizing – the Nickel Metal Hydride (NiMH) battery pack.

Factors That Contribute to Electrical Injury

Current: The higher the current, the more likely it is lethal. Since current is proportional to voltage when resistance is fixed (ohm's law), high voltage is an indirect risk for producing higher currents.

Duration: The longer the duration, the more likely it is lethal—safety switches may limit time of current flow.

Pathway: If current flows through the heart muscle, it is more likely to be lethal.

High voltage (over about 600 volts): In addition to greater current flow, high voltage may cause dielectric breakdown at the skin, thus lowering skin resistance and allowing further increased current flow.

Electrical burns often burn from the inside out. The trauma from a high voltage injury can sometimes lead to limb amputation.

Many electrocution wounds have an entry and an exit spot similar to gunshot wounds.

Never work alone—always have someone near by who can assist you if you are injured working on a high voltage circuit.

Always remove jewelry and watches when working around electricity (even 12-volts)

If someone is shocked, turn off the voltage source, call 911 for help and administer CPR if victim is not breathing.

Always practice the Live—Dead—Live Test

Test something that IS live . . . Something like a 12V battery to make sure your meter is working. Then test the HV circuit you are wanting to test. Then go back to the known good live item tested to make sure your meter is still working properly.

Practice the 1 Hand Rule—

Instead of having both hands on the vehicle's HV cables/components, use an alligator clip with one hand to secure one lead, then use that same hand keeping the other hand away from the HV area.

Personal Protective Equipment—PPE

Eye protection should be worn due to flashover risk.

Class 0/1,000 volt rated isolative rubber gloves and leather shells: The gloves protect you while the leather shells protect the gloves.

Technicians working in automotive recycling operations should decide if purchasing new rubber insulation gloves every 6 (six) months or attaining a certification every 6 (six) months is more cost effective. Class 0 gloves can be purchased through numerous suppliers (e.g., Grainger) or manufacturer direct (e.g., Salisbury).

Properly inspect the gloves prior to every use.

ALWAYS wear gloves WHENEVER working with HV!

Either roll up the gloves to make sure they hold air or blow them up with your mouth to make sure there are no pin holes.

The insulation (rubber) gloves must be recertified every 6 months by an accredited laboratory (see ASTM F496). If recertification is not possible, new gloves should be purchased. After recertification, the laboratory will indicate the date of certification on each rubber glove.





The gloves should never be used without leather protectors. Never use the leather protectors without the rubber insulation gloves to ensure protection against electrical shock.

Never expose the gloves to petroleum products. Products such as detergents, hand soaps or powders may contain petroleum and should not come in contact with the gloves.

The gloves WILL make your hands sweat. Do NOT use normal talcum powder. Most electrical supply companies can send you isolative talcum powder to assist with sweaty hands.

Category III / 1,000 volt Meters AND leads/ends should ALWAYS be used on HV circuits!

Classes Must Be Taken Prior to 12/31/2018

Used Car Dealers may select one of the classes listed below – **any one of these classes will qualify for certification for your license renewal.** On the website classes appear as 5-Hour *Prelicensing* Class but are the 5-Hour *Continuing Ed* Class required by each licensed used car dealer for renewal of their dealer license. Auto salvage dealer license does not have a continuing education component. IIADA decided not to offer Sue's Environmental & Safety class this year.

5-HOUR CONTINUING EDUCATION CLASS MUST BE TAKEN PRIOR TO 12/31/18 - AND START IN JUNE OF 2018. During 2018 the 5-hour dealer continuing education classes will again be held at the community colleges throughout Iowa. The following is an overview of the specialty classes dealers may select from:
